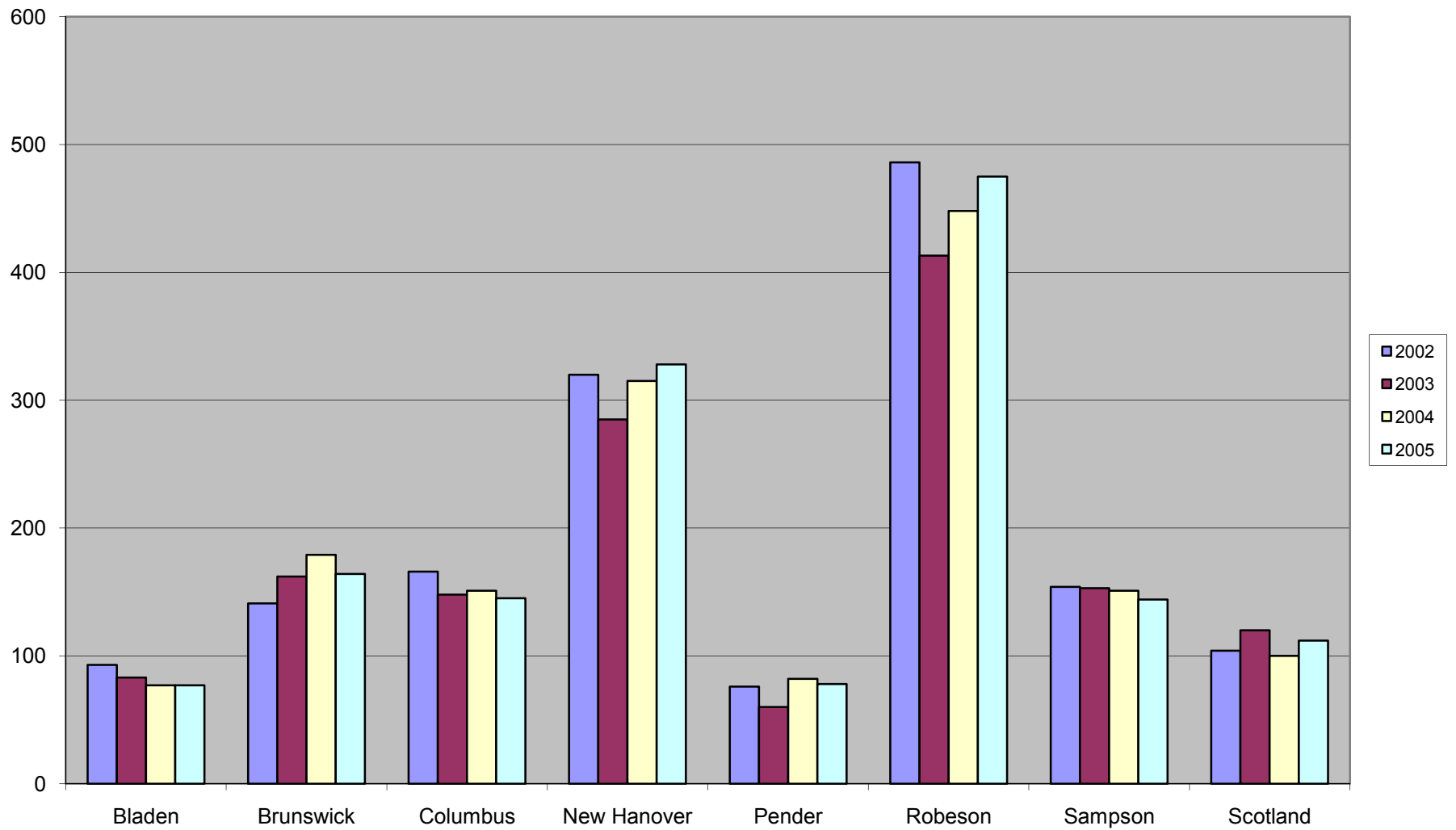

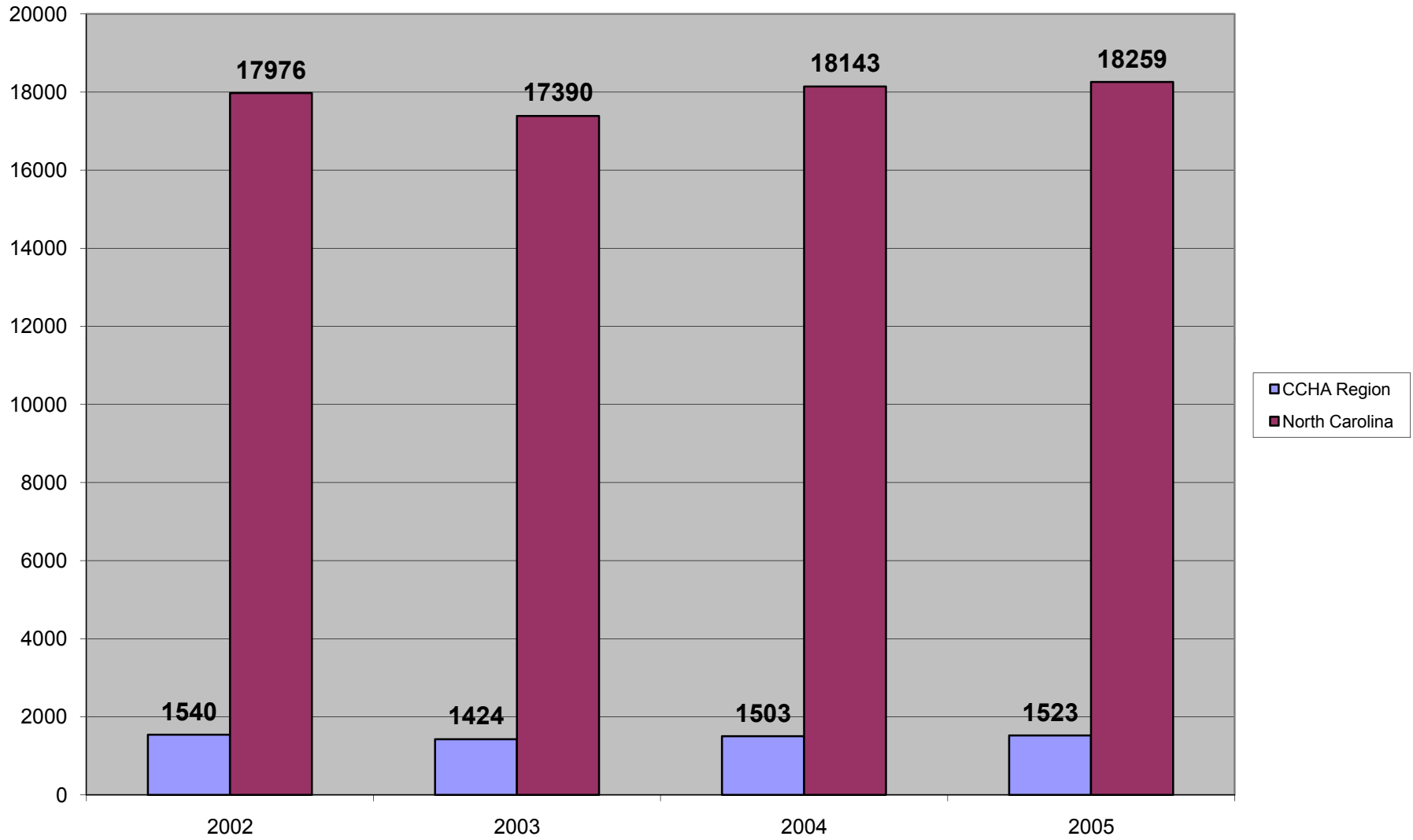

Number of Pregnancies in Females Age 15-19 for CCHA Region vs. North Carolina, 2002-2005



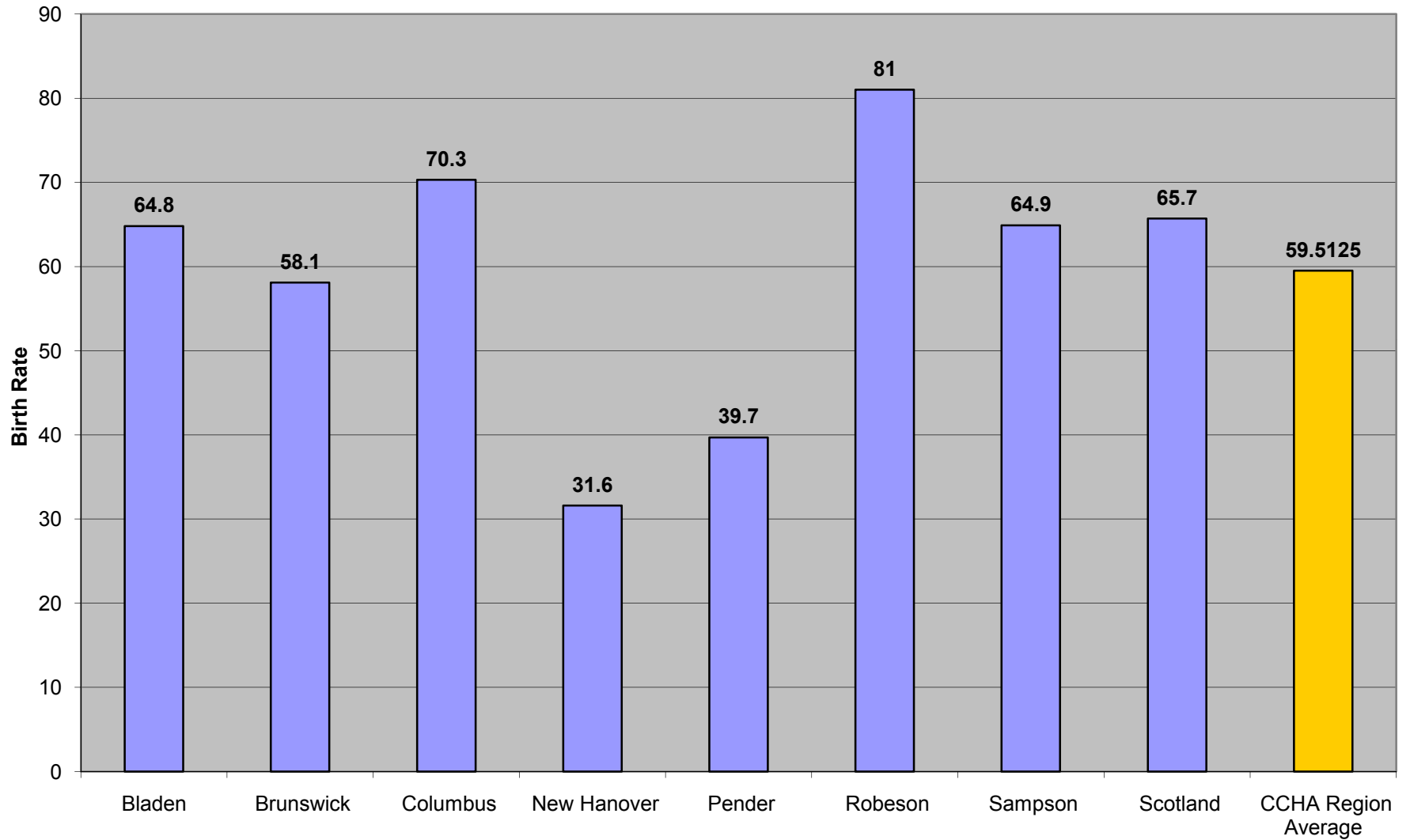

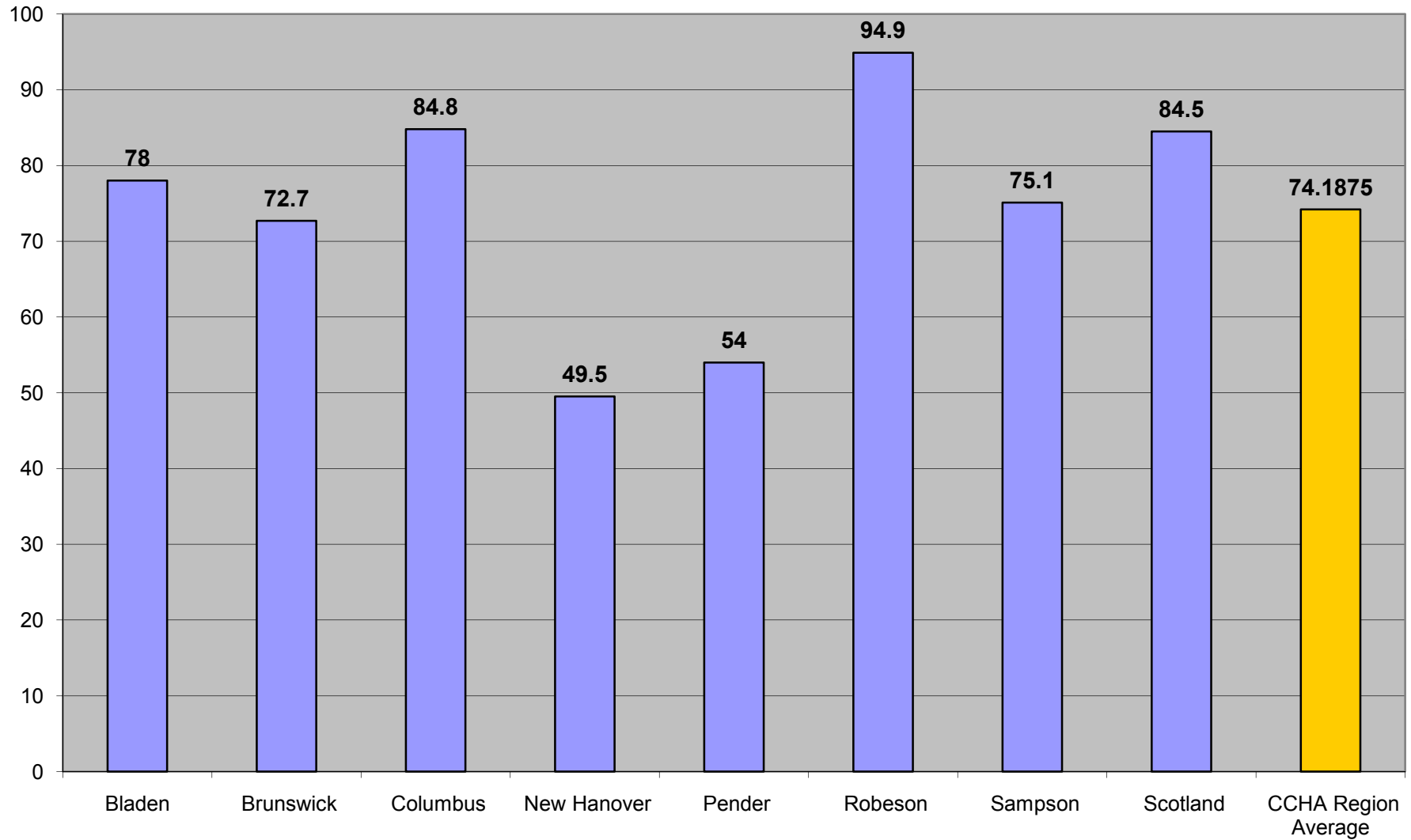
